2) Admission Process:

2.1 Online Registration & Payment of Registration Fee:

- Online Registration:
 - Visit <u>www.nmims.edu</u> for online registration.
 - Before filing the online form, please read all the instructions carefully mentioned in instructions sheet, important dates and also terms & conditions given in online registration form.
- Payment of Registration Fees:
 - Register online on <u>www.nmims.edu</u> & pay Registration Fees of Rs. 1,000/- (Non-refundable). (Please Refer online registration for payment details).

- On the basis of information indicated in the Application Form, invitation for personal interview will be communicated to the candidate as per the above mentioned important dates announced on the NMIMS website.
- Candidates are required to attend the virtual / online personal interview as per the invitation's date and time sent to their registered email ID. The exact time / slot will be communicated in the same invitation. No separate call letter will be mailed or posted to the candidates. It is important and primary requirement to upload the mandatory documents before the Personal Interview.

The list of mandatory documents is as follows:

- 10+2 Examination Passed Marksheet and Certificate (Not applicable for appearing candidates)
- > 10th Examination Passed Marksheet and certificate
- Photo ID proof Aadhaar Card / Passport / Voter ID / Driving License (Learner license will not be accepted)
- No candidate without invitation letter will be permitted to appear for the online personal interview.
- Once passing the Personal Interview and Paying the fees, Provisional admission will be confirmed.
- Candidates are required to be present in person for final admission process before the commencement of the course.

2.2 Structure of Entrance Test: Online Personal Interview

- Online Personal Interview (Total 100 marks)
- Personal Interview will be conducted online (Microsoft Team or Zoom) meeting only.
- Candidate's online personal interview will be conducted on the allotted day only.
- Personal Interview Date and time will be communicated
- Candidates are requested to do not plan any other activity on the interview day and stay available in mobile network & with internet connectivity.

Allocation of Personal Interview Marks (100 marks):

- 1. Communication skills-20 Marks
- 2. Service attitude- 20 Marks
- 3. Interest towards the profession (Why & How)- 10 Marks
- 4. Ability to work hard (both Academic and Profession)-20 Marks

- 5. Academic performance 10th standard (as +2 marks are pending)- 10 marks
- 6. General Knowledge- 10 Marks
- 7. Hobbies & Extra Curricular Activities 10 Marks

3) Selection Process:

- Merit list of admission will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in Online Personal Interview conducted by NMIMS.
- Only selected candidates will be receiving the admission offer letter and the payment link for the fees payment.
- The admission given to the candidates are all on PROVISIONAL basis. Will be confirmed after the submission of all required documents only.
- If at any stage, it is found that a candidate does not satisfy the eligibility criteria or the information furnished by him/her in the application form is incorrect, his/her admission to the course, even if selected, will stand cancelled and the fees will be refunded as per the refund rules prescribed.
- The merit list will be put up on the NMIMS website as per the above mentioned important dates. The decision of the institute will be final in this regard and no inquiries or correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
- 4) **Refund Rules:** The Schedule of refund of fees will be as follows as per UGC rule October 2018:

If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution concerned shall follow the following five-tier system for the refund of fees remitted by the student.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Aggregate fees	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is served to HEI	
(1)	100%	15 days or more before the formally-notified last date of admission (on or before 15 th July 2020)	
(2)	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally-notified last date of admission. (i.e. from 16 th July 2020 to 31 st July 2020)	
(3)	80%	15 days or less after the formally-notified last date of admission (i.e from 1 st August 2020 to 15 th August 2020)	
(4)	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after formally- notified last date of admission (i.e 16 th August 2020 to 30 th August 2020)	
(5)	00%	More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission (i.e from 31 st August 2020 onwards)	

In case of (1) in the table above, the deduction will be 5% of the fees paid as processing charges from the refundable amount, subject to a maximum of Rs 5,000/-.
