 Admission for BBA (Hospitality Operations & Management) program will be offered only through Entrance Test & Personal Interview conducted by NMIMS.

2) Eligibility Criteria (fulfilling all / applicable conditions mandatory):

A candidate must have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination and must have obtained a minimum of
 50% aggregate marks in any stream.

<u>OR</u>

Candidates passing **Diploma Engineering** with Minimum **50% aggregate** marks is eligible to apply.

- 3.2 Candidates appearing / awaiting the results for their final 10+2 or equivalent examination can also apply provided the 10+2 examination have been conducted before the commencement of the program and they meet minimum cut off marks and should be eligible
- 3.3 Candidate of **CBSE & ICSE** should mention in the registration form / e-admission form (if selected) 10+2 or equivalent aggregate marks of all the subjects for which the candidate has taken & appeared for (not best of four, five, six or seven). The candidate shall have passed all the subjects taken & appeared for in the applicable examination/s. In case mark sheet issued by the applicable Board / Institution is in percentile/s, the actual aggregate percentage of all the subjects taken & appeared by the candidate will be taken into consideration for confirming eligibility of the candidate for the program.
- 3.4 Diploma awarded candidates from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board are considered to 10+2 or equivalence examination with 24 grades/credits compulsory and has passed 3 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and 3 subjects at Standard Level (SL) plus extended essay and TOK
- 3.5 **DP course** candidates from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board are considered to 10 +2 or equivalence examination with 2 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and 2 subjects at Standard Level (SL) OR 3 subjects at Standard Level (SL) and 1 subject at Higher Level (HL)
- 3.6 (a) IBCP equivalence for General Strand (Arts, Commerce, Science, Law): CP course candidates from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board are considered 2 DP subjects with at least 1 subject at Higher Level (HL) and minimum 3 points in each DP subject along with Career related studies with at least 03 subjects offered by IB.

(b) IBCP equivalence for Engineering or Medicine Strand: CP course candidates from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board are considered 3 DP subjects (Math, Physics, Chemistry, Biology or other similar subjects) with at least 1 subject at Higher Level (HL) and minimum 03 points in each DP subject along with Career related studies with at least 03 subjects offered by IB.

- 3.7 Note for IB & Cambridge Candidates: Candidates called for admission on the basis of merit list & who do not have final mark sheet will be given "Provisional Admission" based on predicted scores. Fees will be accepted from such candidate, but their admission will be confirmed on submission of final mark sheet, before the commencement of the programme. Mark sheet/Transcripts issued by Board/University/school will be considered
- 3.8 Submission of AIU equivalence certificate to confirm the eligibility for the program is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their (10+2) examination from Overseas Universities. Applicable to candidates of distance learning/ correspondence course/ open school too. If AIU not submitted, then the candidate will be considered as **not eligible**.
- 3.9 Those candidates who have passed, or, are appearing for 10+2 examination from a Board / University where Grade Point Average is given, must produce in writing from the concerned Board / University about the equivalent percentage for the GPA / CGPA obtained.
- 3.10 Candidates above 25 years of age are not eligible to apply.
- 3.11 Only single mark sheet from single board with all compulsory subjects taken / opted and passed will be considered. Compartmentalized mark sheet will not be considered
- 3.12 If at any stage if it is found that, the 10 + 2 marks given by candidate in application form is different from marks actually obtained (as per mark sheet) even if selected/ admitted such candidate admission will be cancelled & fees will be will be refunded as per refund rule clauses.
- 3.13 Candidate whose final mark sheet is not available at the time of admission are required to submit internet copy / Digi-Locker of result duly attested by Principal of the school / college with official seal, failing which candidate will not be admitted for the program.
- 3.14 Candidate will not be eligible if any subject is marked as ungraded / fail in the marksheet / grade sheet. For absent/ungraded in any of the additional/non mandatory subject will be consider as eligible provided such candidate is declared as pass by respective board.

- 3.15 It is sole responsibility of the candidate to ascertain whether they possess necessary and requisite qualification for admission to courses at NMIMS.
- 3.16 Program will commence only if there are a minimum of 20 eligible candidates admitted after the selection process.

5 Selection Process:

Written Test & personal Interview

Structure of Entrance Test:

Written Test (Total 50 marks, 50 questions)

It would be Multiple - Choice test questions. (No negative marking). Total Duration 60 minutes

Syllabus:

- V Current Affairs & General Knowledge (20 questions, 20 marks)
- ✓ Reasoning & Aptitudes (20 questions, 20 marks)
- V English Languages (10 questions, 10 marks)

Personal Interview (Total 50 marks)

- Final merit list will be prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in the Entrance Test & Personal Interview.
- Candidate's Entrance Test and Personal Interview will be conducted on the allotted day only.
- Admission offer is given as per merit and vacant seats available. Selected Candidate has to confirm his / her provisional admission by filling up e-admission form & uploading required document from their dashboard and paying fees within given timeline. Kindly note that only those candidates who complete the process by paying fees will admitted to the program.
- WAITLISTED candidates have to check their merit / offer status as per date given on the website.
- The selection will be solely based on merit only.
- The cut-off for deciding the merit shall lie solely with NMIMS Management.

6. **Program Fees for batch 2025: (for information only)**

- Fees for 1st year BBA Hospitality Operations & Management of Batch 2024 (last year) was Rs. 2,00,000/- p.a.
- Fees for current year (Batch 2025-2028) will be announced at the time of admission.

8. Important instructions:

• For cancellation/ withdrawal of admission: Withdrawal / cancellation means voluntary withdrawal / cancellation by candidate for any reason. Candidate has to upload cancellation form duly filled and signed, fees paid receipt copy & cancelled cheque (personal account) to mentioned link : https://upload.nmims.edu/admission/cancellation

- Candidates whose final mark sheet of the qualified examination is not available at the time of their provisional admission, is required to submit their final marksheet copy as soon as the result declared. In such case, if the candidate fails to meet the required eligibility criteria, then his admission will be cancelled and the fees will be refunded as per NMIMS refund rules (even after course commencement).
- Mark sheet / Transcripts issued by Board / University only be considered (School / Institute will not be accepted).
- Please see the important dates and preserve it as a guide. All announcements from the institute will be through its website <u>www.nmims.edu</u> / on the candidate's dashboard and no individual communication will be sent to the candidates. Kindly check the website regularly for any updates.
- If at any stage, it is found that a candidate does not satisfy the eligibility criteria or the information furnished by him/ her in the application form is incorrect, his/her application for the admission to the program, even if selected, will stand cancelled and fees will be forfeited.
- Candidate's documents will be verified online (if selected) & if found not eligible, admission will be cancelled and fees will be forfeited.
- Canvassing in any form will disqualify the candidate.
- NMIMS has full right to disqualify a candidate at any stage of admission process if found ineligible. No separate intimation will be given.
- Admission to program is considered as "Provisional Admission" till all required and mandatory documents are submitted by the candidate and the same is verified and approved. If it is found that the candidate is not eligible at any stage (even after the course commencement), admission will be cancelled and fees will be refunded as per refund rule clauses, even if selected/ admitted to the program.
- It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to ascertain whether they possess the necessary and requisite qualification for the admission at NMIMS, as verification of the documents is done at the time of final admission.
- All matters of dispute will be subject to the legal jurisdiction of Mumbai only.
